## Packing, storage and transport of the KH-tarpaulins

Folding and rolling of the tarpaulins


Fold the tarpaulings between $1,6 m$ to maximum of $2 m$ width (pic 1)

Fold the other end with kederstrip approximately $0,8 \mathrm{~m}$ inwards and after that begin rolling the tarpaulin from the other end (pic2)

Tie the finished roll with a strap


The width of the folding done in the beginning defines the length of the finished package.
The length of the tarpaulin affects how thick the finished roll will be.
If you did everything according to the instructions you have now a neat and round roll that can be stored in a tube pallet instead of a box

Storage, transport and marking of KH-tarps
Tie a strap at the bottom of the tube pallet to stop the tarpaulins from falling trough
Marking a single tarpaulin
Attach a tag to the tarpaulin, mark the length
Marking multiple similar tarpaulins
mark the length to the tube pallet


All the broken tarps must be marked with the red marking strip
